

Section 5. He shall report to the Council an monthly statement of the receiptd and disbursements of his office, which shall be filed with the Recorder and spread upon the journal of the proceedings of the Council.

Section 6. He shall settle with the Council a mhs accounts at the first regular meeting in each month, and oftener if required.

Section 7. The Treasure shall open and keep a separate and distinct account with each of the several funds into which the finances of the town may be subdivided and such funds shall be kept and neither one shall be kept drawn on for or on account of the other except by order of the Council.

Section 8. That the books of the Town Treasurer be so kept that they will show as to every piece of scrip takenin, date of issue, to whom issued, number, what fund drawnupon, name of party, from whom it was received and a blank for the person to sign from whom received and the person from whom received shall endorse the scrip on back and date, and the Treasurer shall immediately wsite "cancelled" on the face in red ink with date of reception.

Section 9. That all laws and ordinances or parts of laws and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Ordinance No. 100<sup>y</sup>

Fire Department--Organization.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena Arkansas:

Section 1. A fire department for the incorporated town of Mena, Arkansas:

Section 1. A fire department for the i corporate town of Mena, Arkansas, is herevy organized and shall consist of a Fire Chief, to be appointed by the Council together with such assistants as shall b necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, and shall jol the positions during the pleasure of the Council; all of who shall perform their respective servidcs free of charge or expende to the town of Mena, until such time as shall or may be hereafte provided.

Section 2. The Fire Department shall also xonsist of a volunteer fire company of thirty men to act under the direction and command of th Fire Chief and all of the members of the Fire D pa tment shall be exempt from all road or street work and jury service in the corporate limits of the town during such time as they are members thereof.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Chief to keep a close and rigid watch and lool out for fires, and the members of the Fire Company shall be subject to such rules and by laws as may be adopted from time to time by said company and approved by the town Council.
