intrested in the property aburring on said ley, and that said alley is not necessary for Public use.

Section 2. That said alley extending through the middle of Block Twenty-four in the Town of Mena as prerecored plat of said city, on file in the office of the Circuit Clerk of Polk County, Arkansas, be and the same is hereby vacated and its use as an alley be abandoned and prohibited.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and agter its passage and publication.

Relating To The Streets and Avenues In Vneyard Addition to The Town of Mena, Arkansas.

Whereas, A. E.
