Ordinance No. 117

Relating To The Streets and Avenues In the Martin Heights Addition to The Town of Mena, Polk Sounty, Arkansas.

Wheras, th Missouri, Kansas and Texas Trust Company, a corporation oraganized under the laws of the State of Missouri, beking the owner of the following decsribed real property in the County of Polk State of Arkansas to-wit:
