Illegal Cohabitation

Ordinance No. 38 V

Larceny.

Be it ordained by the town council of the incorporated town of Mena, arkansss

Section 1. Any person who shall within the corporate limits of the town of Mena steal, take and carry away or embezzle any money or personal property or effects of another of the value of ten dollars or under shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on comviction therof shall be imprisoned in the town prison not exceeding ten days and shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars.

Section 2. That any person who shall in the corporate limits of the town of Mena take and remove any goods or personal chatteslsor persoanl property of any kins whatso ever of another of the value of the tendollars or less with intent to steal or convert tje same to his or her use, whether the articles be in the immediate possesion of the owner or not, shall be deeped guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction therof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars.

Riot-unlawful Assembly.

Be it ordained by the town Council of the incorporated Town of Mena, Arkansas

Sectionl. If three or more persons assembled together within the corporate limits of the town of Mena, with the intent, or being assembled, sall agree mutually to assist each other to do an unlawful act, with force of violence, against the person or property of another, or accomplish the purpose intended or do any unlawful act in furtherance of such purpose in a violent or turbulent manner, every person so offending or who shall sid or assist in doing any unlawful act shall be adjudged guilty of a mesdemeanor, and on
