Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena Arkansas.

Section 1. That all of said streets alleys and thoroughfares and "Stillwell Park" and "Janssen Park" as indicated on the plat above together to be and the same are hereby accepted by the do porate authorities of the town fares shall be known and designated by the name and names given, and assigned them by the said Arkansas Honstruction Company.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or ride in or through Stillwell Park or Janssen Pack or cut or injure any tree of trees, or hauf away or take off any timber from either of said packs; and it shall also be unlawful for any person to hitch, tie or tether any house, mule, ox, cow, steen, calf or other stock to any tree, staub, stick, fence or other thing, in, around or about either of said packs; any person violating thid ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on comviction fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars for such ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Selling Or Giving Liquor To Indians, Minors or Prisoners.

Be it ordaind by the town Xouncil of the Incorporated Town of Hena, Ack.

Section 1. That any person who shall in the composate limits of the townloof Hand sell or give away any spiritous, vinous or malt liquous to any Indean, or shall sell or give away on spiritous, vinous or malt liquous to any minor without the written consent of his parents or guardian, shall be deemed guilty of a risdemeano, and on conviction the of shall be fined in any sum not less than five no more than twenty-five dollars.

Section 2. That any person who shall in the corporate limits of the town of Mena sell or give away any spiritous or malt hig liquous to any town prisoners while in the custody of any officer of the town, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeance, and on conviction therfor shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Twenty-five dollars.

Section 3/. Thatxanx This ordinance shall take effect and be inf force from and after its passage and publication.
