

~~Ordinance~~ Ordinance No. 60

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any gun or pistol within the corporate limits of the town of Mena unless in self defense or while executing some law or by special permit from the Mayor in case of necessity, no permit to continue more than three days and also excepting the discharge of small target pistols in a licensed shooting gallery. It shall also be unlawful for any person to discharge or shoot off firecrackers, roman candles, or any other kind of fireworks on the public streets of the town of Mena, except by special permit from the Mayor of the town.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 ~~of~~ of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
