

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any gun or pistol within the corporate limits of the town of Mena unless in self defense or while executing some law or by special permit from the Mayor in case of necessity, no permit to continue more than three days and also excepting the discharge of small target pistols in a licensed shooting gallery. It shall also be unlawful for any person to discharge or shoot off firecrackers, Roman candles, or any other kind of fireworks on the public streets of the town of Mena, except by special permit from the Mayor of the town.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollar

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Inclosures For Animals.

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena, Arkansas:

Section 1. Every horse lot cow lot, hog pen or any other inclosures within the city limits of the town of Mena, used to confine and the same proceeding had to remove the same, and the same proceedings had to be taken for the recovery of the expenses of abating of same as are now provided for by ordinance with regard to privies.

Section 2. To cause, create or permit, within the town of Mena, any of the aforesaid nuisances on one's premises, and each day such nuisance is permitted to remain after notice from the town authorities to abate the same shall subject the person or persons responsible for the creation thereof, or for the non abatement of the same, to a fine of not more than ten dollars.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Ordinance No. 62. ✓

Slaughter Pens and Killing Animals for Market.

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena, Arkansas;

Section 1. No slaughter house, slaughter pen, or place for slaughtering or killing beesves, sheep or other animals, shall be established, maintained, or kept in the town shall be fined in like sum.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars, and for each succeeding day that said slaughter house or place for killing said animals shall be maintained, or kept in the town shall be fined in like sum.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
