Sanita y Regulations -- Muisances.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Inco porated Town of Mena A kansas.

Section 1. Every carcass of any animal whatever found lying in any steet or alley or open lot in the town of Mena is hereby declared to be a nuisance; and every owner of such carcass shall remove the same outside of the limits of the town within six hours after being notified by the Marshal, whose duty it shall be to notify said owners immediately after the face of the existence of such nuisance comes to his knowledge. And if any owner of such carcass shall fail to have it removed within the time specified after notice form the a shal, the arshal shall have the carcass removed and collect the expense of such removal eith costs of collection from such owner in such manner as fines are collected. If the arshal shall be unable to find the owner of such carcall, he shall have it immediate—ly removed at the expense of the town.

Section 2. Every privy or necessary house placed so near a street to offend the dight or kept in such a condition as to offend the smell of persons passing, is hereby declared to be a nuisance, and the la shall on vecoming aware of the fact shall notify the occupant of the lot to remove or abate such nuisance, and if such occupant fails to do so wi thin twenty-four hours it shall be removed or abated by the Earshal.

Section 3. All offal, tainted meat, or filth of any kind thrown into or left on any street, alley or lane of the toenis hereby declared to be a nuisance, and every pan of standing water, or anything whatever that is deleterioue to healthof any citizen is he eby declared to be a nuisance, and shall be abated.

Section 4. No person shall be allowed to throw any animal or vegetable substande--straw, jay, paper, ashes, or any other article or sucstance whatever upon any street, alleyor public place of the town or; upon any property contiguous thereto.

Section 5.k All horse offal and all articles enumerated in the preedeing sections of this ordinace, at privare redidences, boading houses, hotels and othe public houses, shall be disposed of in duch a manne s not to interfere eith th health of the town. Nor shall any person allow any filth, dirt or over uctions of any kind to accumulate in the gutters in front of his property, and all owners and occupants of proper in frongt of which gut ers have been gade shall keep hum xlvN ND FREE F FROM TASH mud and wll other obst uctions to the wAY and rapid flow of water through them.

Section 6. Any person failing to comply eith the providions of the fore ong Sections of this ordinance shall bay the expension of all removal or abatement of nuisances made by the Marshal and upon conciction shall pay a fine of not less than fifteen dollars for each day the same may be cintinued; all notices given by the Marshal to parties for the remocal or abatement of nuisances shall be in writing and every notice read or given to such person or left at his place of residence with some member of the household not less than fifteen years of age shall be deemed a legal notice.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
