Ordinance No. 19 ✓

Be it ordained by the town council of the incorporated Town of Mena Arkansas;

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to leave any team of horses or mules hitched to any wagon, carriage, cart or vehicle in this town, without someone in charge of the same.

Section 2. That it shall be the duty of the Marshal when he shall find such a team so hitched to take charge of the same and to arrest the person or persons for so ~~vix~~ leaving it and take him or them before the Mayor who shall on conviction of such person or persons for so violating this ordinance fine him or them in the sum of one dollar and such team shall remain in charge of the marshal until said fine and cost shall be paid.

Section 3. That all laws and ordinances or parts of laws or ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Ordinance No. 26 ✓

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated town of Mena Arkansas;

Section 1. If two or more persons shall by agreement fight, to the terror of any citizen of this town within the incorporated town of Mena Arkansas the person or persons so offending shall be deemed guilty of an assault and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it's passage and publication.

Ordinance No. 27 ✓
assault and Assault and battery

Be it ordained by the Town council of the Incorporated city of Mena Arkansas;

Section 1. Any person who shall within the incorporated limits of the town of Mena Arkansas commit a simple assault upon or against the person of another shall be fined in any sum not exceeding ten dollars.

Section 2. Any person who shall within the corporate limits of the town of Mena commit the offense of assault and battery upon the person of another shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated town of Mena Arkansas;
