

kind whatsoever of another of the value of ten dollars or less with intent to steal or convert the same to his or her use, whether the articles be in the immediate possession of the owner or not, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

PROFANITY.

*Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena, Arkansas:*

Section 1. Any person who shall profanely swear or curse, or shall use loud, indecent or vulgar language in public places on the streets of Mena, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in the sum of one dollar for every such offense.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
