Ordinance No. 45. ✓

In Relation to bonds and Security for Appearance.

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated Town of Mena Arkansas.

Section 1. Any person arrested within the corporate limits of the town of Mena Arkansas for a violation of a town ordinance may be admitted to bail for his appearance at the Mayor's court at the next morning session thereafter by executing a bond to the town of Mena with sufficient security approved by the town Marshal, deputy or other police officer in double the amount of the highest penalty provided by ordinance for the alleged offense conditioned that the said person will appear on the day therein named before the Mayor's court to await his trial on the charge against him and will not depart thence without the leave of the court, and all bonds so taken shall be filed with the Mayor.

Section 2. If the defendant shall fail to appear according to the conditions of said bond or having appeared shall depart without a trial or the leave of the court, the court shall declare the bond forfeited and make a record entry the necessary steps to obtain judgment thereon and execution thereof in the court having proper jurisdiction; provided, that such forfeiture may be set aside by the defendant appearing within ten days after said forfeiture.

Section 3. Whenever any person within the corporate limits of the town of Mena shall be arrested by the town Marshal or other police officer in double the amount of the highest penalty he shall be allowed to make a deposit of money or other valuable things as security for his appearance before the Mayor's court at its next sitting thereafter if said defendant shall make default in appearance before the Mayor's court the deposit so made shall be declared forfeited; if money, after payment of the cost of the officers the balance shall be turned over to the treasurer; if other valuable things the same shall be sold by order of the court at public auction for cash, after ten days notice of the time and place of sale, in some newspaper published in the town of Mena, and the proceeds thereof, after the payment of cost, be turned over to the town Treasurer.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Relating to streets, alleys, Bridges, Parks and Public Buildings.

Be it ordained by the town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena, Arkansas.

Whereas, the Arkansas Construction Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the state of Missouri, being the owner of the following described real property situated in the county of Polk, State of Arkansas, to wit:

The south half of the southeast quarter, and the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter, section 7; also the northeast quarter, the east half of the northwest quarter, the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter, the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter, section 18; also the west half of the northwest quarter
