

Section 8. All repairs and improvements on the streets shall be paid out of the public treasury; sidewalks shall be made and repaired at the expense of the individual owner of lots and it shall be the duty of the owner or agent of property to keep the sidewalks in front of their property in good repair, and upon failure to do so the Marshal shall notify them to make such repair as are necessary and them if they fail to repair the same the Marshal have such repairs made at the expense of the owner or agent.

Section 9. It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to erect, build or place any fence of any material or construction, or any house, outhouses, tents or other kind of building whether in, upon or across any street, alley or public grounds of the Town. And any person violating any of the provisions of this Section shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars, and not exceeding fifteen dollars for every subsequent day that such obstruction shall remain.

Section 10. Any person who shall loosen or remove any plank, board, block, brick, stone or stringer or support from any sidewalk or crosswalk or from any curbstone gutter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and conviction thereof shall be fined not exceeding ten dollars.

Section 11. This ordinance shall take effect and in force from and after its passage and publication.

Trespassing on Public Property.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena Arkansas:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to cut or break off any limbs or twigs or otherwise injure any tree, shrub or plant growing in or on Janssen Park or Stilwell Park, or to cut or otherwise mark any such tree, shrub or plant being and growing in or upon either of said parks or in or upon any other Parks or public grounds or streets of said town of Mena.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to leave open the gates leading into either Janssen Park or Stilwell Park in said town, or to break or damage the public Pagodas or the seats therein said Park.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1 and 2 of this ordinance shall be punished for each and every such offense by a fine of not exceeding ten dollars.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
