Ordinance No. 87 v

Warrants.

Be it ordained by the town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena Arkansas:

Section 1. That all accounts, bills, claims or demands against the incorporated town of Mena, Arkansas, must be presented to and approved and allowed by the Council, and when the work is done for which said bill, claims or demands which are represented, at the instance of the Marshal or an committee, ; it shall first be certified to by the Marshal or committee, and then approved by the Council; whereupon the Recorder shall issue a warrant, signed by the Mayor, and countersigned by the Recorder.

Section 2. That the Recorder shall keep a book in which he shall enter the amount of each warrant and the date of its issue, and he shall number them consecutively.

Section 3. That all laws and ordinances or parts of laws and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Ordinance No. 89 v

Sanitary.

Be it ordained by the town Council of the Incorporated town of Mena Arkansas:

Section 1. The board of Health of the incorporated town of Mena Arkansas: shall have the power to declare a nuisance and report the same to the Mayor, whose duty it shall be to cause same to be enjoined or order the abatement, discontinuance or removal thereof, or any matter, thing, house, substance, act, practice or carrying on which in its nature, tendency, effect or discontinuance, is, or may become dangerous, injurious or detrimental to the health of the town or its inhabitants.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of each and every physician practicing in this town to report to the Board of Health or some member thereof immediately, any and all contagious or infectious diseases that may occur in their practice.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the occupant of each and every house, store, hotel, livery, sale or private stable, barn yard or other place within the town to gather up all official, trash, animal and vegetable matter, and unclean liquid created or found on
