

Ordinance No. 91. ✓

Relating To Gambling

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena Arkansas;

Section 1. Every person who shall within the corporate limits of the town of Mena, set up, keep or exhibit any gambling table or gambling device commonly called "L. B. C.," "E. O.," roulette, rouge et noir, or any faro bank, ~~or any~~ of the like or similar kind, or of any description, although not herein named, be the name or denomination what it may adapted, devised or designed for the purpose of playing any game of chance or at which any money or property may be won or lost, shall thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars.

Section 2. If any person shall in any way, either directly or indirectly, be interested or concerned in any gaming prohibited by Section 1, either by furnishing money or other articles for the purpose of carrying on gaming or being interested in the loss or gain of such prohibited gaming, he shall be fined as in Section 1.

Section 3. If any person shall be guilty of betting any money or valuable thing, or any representative of anything that is esteemed of value on any of the games herein prohibited, on conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than five nor more than one hundred dollars.

Section 4. If the owner or occupant of any house, out-house, or other building in the town of Mena, shall knowingly permit any of the before mentioned games, tables or banks or shall suffer any kind of gaming, under any name whatsoever, to be carried on or exhibited in their houses or out-houses or other buildings, on conviction thereof every such owner or occupant shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars.

Section 5. If any person within the corporate limits of Mena shall be guilty of betting any money or any valuable thing on any game of brag, bluff, poker, seven up, twenty-one, vingtun, thirteen cards, the odd trick, forty five, whist, high-five, or any other game at cards known by name or without any name, he shall on conviction be fined in any sum not less than ten nor more than twenty-five dollars.

Section 6. If any person within the corporate limits of the town of Mena shall be guilty of betting any money or any valuable thing on any game of hazard or skill, he shall on conviction be ~~be~~ fined in any sum not less than ten nor more than twenty-five dollars.

Section 7. That all laws and ordinances or parts of laws and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

obscenity

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Mena

and all other things likely to impair the health of said town, and to keep all their hen houses, hog pens, pig styes, water closets privies and out houses of every kind and character, cow lots and yards within the town under their control in such clean sanitary condition as shall meet the approval of the Board of Health.

Section 4. No person shall be allowed to conduct into any street alley or other public place of the town any filth or soil or unclean water to escape from his or her house, kitchen or other tenement or to suffer any such filth or soil or unclean water to escape from his or her premises upon any of the places above mentioned or upon any property contiguous thereto.

Section 5. No owner, keeper or occupant of any livery or sales stable, nor any other person who may keep horses, mules, oxen, cows, or other animals on his or her premises, for public or private use or for sale, shall allow any filth or other offensive matter to accumulate in or near such stable or residence from the keeping or taking care of any such animals above mentioned.

Section 6. All rules, orders or regulations of the Board of Health adopted under the powers and authority hereby granted shall after due publication, have the full force and effect of ordinances of the town and whoever shall disobey or violate any of the said orders, rules or regulations shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, before the Mayor of this town shall be fined in any sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars for each offense.

Section 7. That all laws and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.

Ordinance No. 90 ✓

Weapons

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated town of Mena Arkansas.

Section 1. That any person who shall in the corporate limits of the town of Mena, wear or carry in any manner whatever as a weapon, any dirk or bowie knife or a sword or a spear in a cane, bass or metal knucks, razor or any pistol of any kind whatever, except such pistols or any kind whatever as are used in the army or navy of the United States when carried uncovered or in the hand, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than fifty nor more than three hundred dollars; provided, further, that nothing in this ordinance shall prohibit any person from carrying any weapon when upon a journey or upon his own premises.

Section 2. That all laws and ordinances or parts of laws and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication.
