

Section 2. Whoever shall go to the domicile or usual place of abode of any person or being at the domicile or usual place of abode of any person within the corporate limits of the town of Mena, shall utter or publish vulgar and profane language or shall make any vulgar exhibition in the presence of any person then and there being or shall make any violent threats against any person usually dwelling at such or any person then and there being with intent to insult or terrify any person, whatsoever, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than five nor more than fifty dollars.

Section 3. That all laws and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Ordinance No. 94. ✓

Prize fighting.

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated Town of Mena, Arkansas:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to fight a prize fight either with or without gloves in the town of Mena, and it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to act as second or referee at any prize fight in this town, or to otherwise participate in the same. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ten nor more than one thousand dollars.

Section 2. That all laws and ordinances or parts of laws and ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Ordinance NO. 93. ✓

Town Treasurer--Duties Of.

Be it ordained by the town council of the Incorporated Town of Mena, Arkansas:

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the town treasurer to receive and receipt for and safely keep all moneys paid into the town treasury and shall pay and disburse the same on warrants drawn in accordance with the regulations of the town Council.

Section 2. He shall keep a true and correct account of all moneys received and disbursed and a regular abstract of all moneys paid by him.

Section 3. He shall make duplicate receipts in favor of the proper person for all moneys paid into the treasury and keep the books, papers and moneys pertaining to his office at all times open to inspection of the Mayor and Council.
